Please can you make sure your child has appropriate clothing and footwear during Preschool session.

#### Water Bottles

Please make sure your child has a suitable, **labelled**, drink container filled with **WATER ONLY**, so they can access a drink throughout the session.

PLEASE can you label all items of clothing, bags, water bottles, coats etc.

#### Illness/Absence

If your child has a temperature make sure they stay at home and give them plenty of fluids please don't give them Calpol and send them to Preschool. In case of sickness or diarrhoea, please do not send them in until a clear '48 hours' has passed. These types of bugs spread very quickly in the setting. If your child is absent for any reason, please bring in a note (if you know in advance) or telephone on the day.

#### School Premises and Infant School Play Equipment

Please remember that the whole of the School site is a non smoking site and for the safety of all children, to close the gates either after entering or leaving the site and if you drive, please park with consideration for the residents and do not park on the double yellow lines. We also remind you that we are not responsible for any scooters/bikes left on our site. The infant play equipment should not be used by children on their way in or out of school
